African Swine Fever continues among wild boar in the state of Hessen

As is evident from the table above, the authorities in Germany continue to find many cases of African Swine Fever among dead wild boar.

According to German media, the area most affected lies south of Frankfurt in the state of Hessen.

Cases have also been confirmed outside the mobile fencing, which have resulted in the authorities expanding the current core zones and erecting a new fence.

Hessen was first hit by the virus among wild boar in June.



AMI: Continued profits for German finisher

producers in model calculation

The Agricultural Market Information company's model calculation shows that German finisher producers continue to earn money and have been in profit since the spring of 2023.

According to the model calculation, this follows an extended period – from 2020 to 2023 – of losses for German finisher producers.

In mid-October, finisher producers made a profit of EUR 7.80 per pig, which is close to the average since the spring of 2023.

October's calculation, however, was produced before the fall in the German pig price of 8 cents/kg. Piglet prices have also seen a fall.



Total pig meat storage on a par with one year ago

Attorney General supports attempt to overturn legislation for higher animal welfare in Massachusetts

lowa's Attorney General, Brenna Bird, has announced her support for current efforts to overturn the new welfare legislation in Massachusetts, the so-called Massachusetts Question 3.

The legislation corresponds to California's Proposition 12, which bans the sale of pig meat in the state from pigs not bred according to the state's animal welfare regulations.

The new welfare regulations in Massachusetts and California have met with significant opposition from states such as lowa, where a large proportion of the nation's pig meat supply is produced.

Brenna Bird believes that the new animal welfare regulations will lead to generally higher prices for consumers and limit access to the pig meat market for pig producers in Iowa who are unable to meet the new standards.

The Attorney General remains optimistic about overturning the law.



Modest rise in pig meat imports in Q3 compared to the previous two quarters this year The Chinese authorities have published their import figures for Q3 2024.


Both fresh/frozen pig meat and by-products have seen a slight increase in Chinese imports in Q3 compared to the two previous quarters in 2024. Imports of fresh/frozen pig meat, however, are still significantly lower in Q3 than in previous years.

The chart below shows the quarterly development in China's pig meat imports since Q1 2020, divided into fresh/frozen pig meat (product code 0203) and by-products (product code 020649).

As can be seen, Chinese pig meat imports peaked from Q2 2020 to Q2 2021, which was when China's domestic pig meat production was affected by African Swine Fever.

There was a modest increase in imports in Q4 2022 and in Q1 2023, but after this imports fell again to their current level of below 600,000 tonnes in the last four quarters.

Fresh/frozen pig meat has seen the most significant fall, while imports of by-products have been more stable. Since Q1 2024, imports of by-products have been higher than imports of fresh/frozen pig meat.
