# PHILIPPINES

### Vaccination against African Swine Fever expanded to new areas

Having vaccinated against African Swine Fever in areas affected by the disease, the authorities in the Philippines are expanding the programme to include areas where no active cases have been reported, reports Pig 333.

The Philippines' Agriculture Ministry is therefore distributing a further 150,000 doses containing the AVAC live vaccine following completion of the vaccination programme in areas affected by African Swine Fever.



#### Vietnam has used 5.9 million doses of the African Swine Fever vaccine

Pig 333, citing the authorities in Vietnam, reports that Vietnam has so far used 5.9 million doses of the vaccine against African Swine Fever.

The disease hit the country in February 2019 and the vaccination programme began in February 2023. Vietnam has approved and produces two vaccines against the disease. They are from NAVETCO and AVAC.

# Trump appoints Brooke Rollins as agriculture secretary

President-elect Donald Trump has nominated his former political adviser in the White House, Brooke Rollins, as the new agriculture secretary. Like all other nominations, the US Senate still needs to approve Rollins' nomination.

Brooke Rollins, 52, grew up on a farm in Texas. A lawyer by training, she is currently president of the America First Policy Institute (AFPI).

According to U.S. media, AFPI is a conservative think tank founded by Trump supporters. She worked closely with the Republican Party's election campaign team.



## Pork industry urges caution against punitive tariffs on goods from Mexico and Canada

Trump's proposal to impose a punitive 25 per cent tariff on goods from Mexico and Canada has been received with some concern by the U.S. pig meat industry.

The industry fears the consequences if a trade war were to develop with the two countries.

U.S. exports of pig meat to Mexico have been developing positively over the past years and Mexico is by far the largest export market for U.S. pig meat.

Although Canada is further down the list of the largest markets for U.S. pig meat, imports of pig meat and piglets from Canada are also substantial.

According to the U.S. media, the U.S. pig meat industry has urged U.S. policymakers to carefully consider the wider economic consequences of reintroducing increased tariffs on the two countries.

The pig meat industry says that they will closely monitor developments and is advocating for policies that prioritise market stability.
