New case of African Swine Fever at a pig farm in Hesse

Last week, the German authorities found a second case of African Swine Fever at a pig farm in the state of Hesse. The new case comes after the first was confirmed at a farm in Hesse last week.

African Swine Fever was first found in Hesse in mid-June among wild boar. Since then, more than 20 dead wild boar have been reported as having the disease.

In the neighbouring state of Lower Saxony, African Swine Fever was recently found among wild boar. In addition to the usual measures, the authorities there have introduced a range of measures to counter the spread.

It is still unclear as to how the virus reached the two West German states.



EU pig slaughtering increased by 2 per cent for the period January-April 2024

All EU countries have now reported their pig slaughtering figures to Eurostat for the first four months of 2024.

New outbreak of African Swine Fever

International news media reports that the Philippines has recently been hit by a number of new cases of African Swine Fever.

The area around Cebu City has been affected once again after having been declared free from African Swine Fever in May.

The authorities previously announced that a vaccination programme against African Swine Fever is expected to start in September.



Danish Crown among three companies named as targets in China's anti-dumping investigation The Chinese authorities have targetted three European companies in their anti-dumping investigations into pig meat products from the EU.

The three companies are Danish Crown, the Dutch Vion Boxtel, the Spanish Litera Meat (Pini Group).

China already announced in June that, in response to the EU introducing punitive tariffs on electric cars from China, it would initiate an anti-dumping investigation into imports of pig meat from the EU.



Imports of by-products surpass imports of fresh/frozen pig meat in H1 2024

The Chinese authorities have published import figures for Q2 2024.


As was the case in Q1, imports of by-products in Q2 surpassed imports of fresh/frozen pig meat. Compared to Q1, imports of fresh/frozen pig meat were stable whereas there was a slight increase in the import of by-products.

The chart below shows the quarterly trend in China's pig meat imports since Q1 2020, broken down into fresh/frozen pig meat (product code 0203) and by-products (product code 020649).

As can be seen, China's pig meat imports peaked between Q2 2020 and Q2 2021 when China's domestic production was hit by African Swine Fever.

There was a modest rise in imports in Q4 2022 and in Q1 2023, but a fall to the current level over the past three quarters.

The fall in imports of fresh/frozen pig meat has been most significant, while imports of by-products have been more stable.

Authorities to reduce sow numbers

Pig333 reports that the authorities in Thailand have initiated a project to reduce the number of sows in the country.

The aim is to reduce the number of sows by 78,571 head at 230 large farms with more than 1,000 sows.

The authorities have called on the larger farms to participate in the project with the aim of creating a better balance in the pig meat market and preventing pig producers from experiencing continued losses.



African Swine Fever at a farm

The authorities in Thailand have reported an outbreak of African Swine Fever at a small farm in Chiang Mai.

This is the first case in the country to be reported since September 2023.



Stable exports of pig meat in H1

The table below shows the official figures for Brazil's exports of fresh/frozen pig meat for January-June 2024 compared to the same period in the previous two years.

As can be seen, Brazil's total pig meat exports in H1 2024 were largely on par with the corresponding period last year.

Although there was a significant fall in exports to China and Hong Kong, this was more than offset by rising exports to a number of other export markets for Brazilian pig meat.

Maple Leaf to create two companies – a new pig production company and Maple Leaf Foods International news media report that the Canadian company, Maple Leaf, is to split into two public companies – a new, unnamed pork company and Maple Leaf Foods.

The new pig production company will have around 85,000 sows and two slaughter plants. The largest will be in Brandon, Manitoba and the smaller in Lethbridge, Alberta.

Last year, Maple Leaf slaughtered 4 million pigs, but has a capacity for 5 million.

The new company will have a supply agreement with Maple Leaf to supply pork to Maple Leaf Foods. The breakdown of sales will be about 1/3 to Maple Leaf Foods, 1/3 to current export markets and 1/3 to retail fresh pork in Canada and the US.

Maple Leaf will retain 19.9 per cent ownership of the new pig production company.

In future, Maple Leaf Foods will handle sales of processed meat, including brands such as Schneiders, and will continue to sell poultry and plant protein products.



Pig meat storage at end May 9 per cent lower than one year ago

With the USDA as the source, the table below shows the latest calculations for American storage of pig meat as at 31 May 2024 compared to the previous month and to one year ago.

Overall pig meat storage was 9.4 per cent lower compared to one year ago and declined by 3.5 per cent compared to the previous month.

Beef storage was 0.5 per cent lower compared to one year ago and 3.4 per cent lower than the previous month.

As regards poultry, storage was 5.3 per cent lower compared to one year ago, but rose 3.5 per cent compared to the previous month.
