African Swine Fever confirmed in a wild boar in the German state of Hessen

Last week, the German state of Hessen confirmed a case of African Swine Fever in a dead wild boar.

Hessen is located in western Germany, around 350 km from Denmark. How the disease spread is yet unknown.

The German authorities have introduced the usual measures to prevent further spread and have stated that they will draw on the experience gained from combatting the virus in Eastern Germany where it has so far been contained.



Continued decline in pig population in the two German states of Lower Saxony and Baden-Württemberg

Preliminary pig population figures for Lower Saxony and Baden-Württemberg as at 3 May show a continued decline, reports ISN in Germany.

In Lower Saxony, preliminary figures from the May census show a total pig population of 6.93 million. This is a fall of 1.9 per cent compared to one year ago. The breeding sow population is 3.0 per cent lower than one year ago. Finisher farms show a fall of 3.6 per cent, while the number of sow farms has been reduced by 4.0 per cent.

Baden-Württemberg has recorded a total pig population of 1.25 million. This is a fall of 1.8 per cent compared to one year ago. The breeding sow population, however, has risen by 1.1 per cent.

Figures from the May 2024 census for the pig population of other German states will be published over the coming weeks.



German pig slaughtering rose by 2 per cent for the first four months of the year

According to AMI, German pig slaughtering – at 14.9 million - for the first four months of 2024 is 2.0 per cent higher than the same period last year. A slight rise in carcase weight means that, measured in tonnage, production rose by 2.9 per cent.

The rise of 2 per cent applies both to domestic finishers and finishers imported for slaughter in Germany.

The rise in German slaughtering follows the fact that annual slaughtering has shown uninterrupted falls between 2016-2023. In the last two years, German slaughtering fell by 9 and 7 per cent respectively. In the previous years, the fall has been between 2-3 per cent.



Threat of tariffs on EU pig meat looms closer

International media report that the Chinese threat of additional tariffs on EU pig meat has become more likely after the EU Commission announced on Wednesday last week that it plans to introduce punitive tariffs on electric cars from China.

The Chinese authorities previously warned the EU that China is prepared to hit the European aviation and agricultural sectors if the EU does not withdraw from the impending trade war with China.

According to China's state-controlled Global Times, the Chinese authorities have now launched an investigation into whether to impose extra tariffs on a number of pig meat products from the EU.



Outbreak of Classical Swine Fever among wild boar in a major production area

In June, the authorities in Japan detected Classical Swine Fever in two dead wild boar near the town of Karatsu on the island of Kyushu, the third largest of Japan's four main islands.

This is the first time for Classical Swine Fever to be found on Kyushu, which, with 2.8 million pigs, has around one-third of Japan's 8.95 million pigs, reports Pig333.

Japan's Agriculture Ministry plans to increase the monitoring and culling of wild boar in certain areas. A vaccination programme for pig farms will also continue at the same time.




Denmark's exports of pig meat January-March 2024



Stable earnings for British pig producers continue in Q1 2024

The British trade association, AHDB, reports that British pig producers posted average earnings of £16 per pig in Q1 2024.

This is the fourth quarter in succession where AHDB's model calculations have shown positive earnings for British pig producers. Earnings in the three previous quarters have ranged between £19 and £25 per pig.

This follows an extended period of negative earnings, i.e. the eight quarters of 2021 and 2022.



Vion to sell shares in Topigs Norsvin

Vion is selling its shares in the pig genetics company, Topigs Norsvin, reports Topagrar.

As was published in last week's Market News, Vion has opened up for the sale of its German activities. It is reviewing its assets in Germany and shifting its future focus towards strengthening chains in the Benelux.
